Thank you for your request for information received on 18 July 2022 which was dealt with under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000. Northern Ireland Ambulance Service (NIAS) Health and Social Care Trust has now completed its search for the information you requested and that is detailed below.

Question 1

In the last 12 months (From July 1, 2021 to July 17, 2022), how many attacks on NIAS staff have been carried out?

Answer 1

There have been 684 incidents of abuse/attacks within this timeframe.

Please note 'Attacks' include: Verbal, Physical, Psychological and Sexual forms of abuse.

Question 2

For the same period, how many NIAS staff have taken time off work 'stress related'?

Answer 2

Based on records from HRPTS the number of staff off during the above mentioned period with work related stress was 37 staff members.

I hope this fully assists you. If you are dissatisfied in any way with the handling of your request, you have the right to request a review. You should do this as soon as possible, or in any case within two months of the date of issue of this letter.

If following an internal review, carried out by an independent decision maker, you remain dissatisfied in any way with the handling of the request, you may make a complaint under Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act, to the Information Commissioner's Office and ask that they investigate whether the Trust has complied with the terms of the Freedom of Information Act.
