Northern Ireland Ambulance Service (NIAS) Health and Social Care Trust has now completed its search for the information you requested and that is detailed below.

What are the roles and responsibilities of a Station Supervisor? | Please find attached '35115-24 Job Description - Station Supervisor - Various Locations' job description and person specification for the post and which outlines the roles and responsibilities. |
| 2. How many staff members does a Station Supervisor line manage? | This will vary from Division to Division however line management and which are outlined in the job description, and which include in the job summary: Responsibility for day-to-day management of a Station(s) including operational and clinical supervision of the appropriate staff during the period of a shift or duty. |
| 3. Does a Station Supervisor work the same shift dates and times as the staff that they line manage? | Whilst on duty, Station Supervisors have a Line Management responsibility for all other staff who are on duty at that time. NIAS do not operate a 'team' based approach to line management |
| 4. Can you provide a chart or information that shows who line manages a Station Supervisor and what their role and responsibilities are? | Please find attached job description and person specification for the post which provides the information on who the Station Supervisor reports to and accountable to. |
