Thank you for your request for information received on 28/01/2023 which was dealt with under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000. Northern Ireland Ambulance Service (NIAS) Health and Social Care Trust has now completed its search for the information you requested and that is detailed below.

Question

- 1. How many people applied?
- 2. How many people got an interview?
- 3. How many people got onto the waiting list?
- 4. How many vacancies are going within NEAC?

Answer

- Based on information from HRPTS, there were 65 applicants for the NEAC call taker post.
- 2. Based on information from HRPTS, there were 38 candidates shortlisted for interview
- 3. Based on information from HRPTS, there were 11 candidates placed on a waiting list
- 4. There are currently no full time or part time vacancies within the funded establishment of NEAC.
